Cinco de Mayo

Cinco de Mayo, Spanish for "the fifth of May," celebrates the defeat of the French at the Battle of Puebla, which took place on May 5, 1862. Celebrating Cinco de Mayo has become increasingly popular in the DFW area. Many celebrate the day with dancing, music, food and beverages. Many restaurants and bars offer specials and live music. **What:** Cinco de Mayo Big Parade & Festival. The Big Parade is the largest Cinco de Mayo parade in North Texas with over 20,000 in attendance. This colorful event includes marching bands, folkloric dance groups, school groups and much more. **When:** Saturday, May 5th. Big Parade starts at 11:00a.m. and ending about 12:30p.m. The Festival runs from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. at 600 W. Jefferson. **Where:** Historic downtown Oak Cliff. The festival is on the 600 block of W. Jefferson Blvd. The Big Parade begins at 200 E. Jefferson and ends at 1000 W. Jefferson Blvd.

Richardson's Cottonwood Art Festival

The bi-annual Cottonwood Art Festival, featuring works from the nation's top visual artists. Now in its 44th year, the prestigious show is rated the fifth best art festival in the United States, and is the premier fine arts event in North Texas. Admission is Free. May 5th 10am-8pm & May 6th 10am-5pm at Cottonwood Park in Richardson.
